Venue:

Iran ANGVA 2017 will take place in Milad Tower convention center in Tehran, Iran. Tehran is a great metropolis, which is the focal point of Iran's transportation network and the center in which more than 40% of the nation's economic activities takes place.







Milad Tower is a multi-purpose tower. It is the sixth tallest tower and the 17th tallest freestanding structure in the world.

Milad Convention center's main parts are seven conference salons, 5 VIP rooms and exhibition area of 6900 m2 with a parking area of 27,000 m2.

Very easy access to international hotels and bus terminals are amongst other advantages of this convention center.

General information



Iran Air offers a global network of flights linking Tehran with most of the major cities throughout the world. In case, you are flying from cities that Iran Air does not cover, please check with other airlines office or with your travel agency.

Airport transfer:

Conference executive committee will use its best efforts to provide airport transfer for exhibitors and attendees arriving Imam Khomeini International Airport (IKA). More information is available on ANGVA 2017 website.

Passport and Visa:

Every foreign visitor entering Iran, must possess a valid passport and visa. Participants from countries requiring a visa entry to Iran are strongly advised to make their applications in their home countries at least one month before the intended date of travel.

However, conference executive committee will issue a formal invitation letter. At least one of the following criteria must be met in order to honor the request for a letter of invitation. The requesting party must either:

- Be an author of an accepted paper.
- Have paid the advanced registration fee for the conference.
- Be an exhibitor in ANGVA 2017 exhibition.

Banks and currency exchange:

The currency is the Iranian Rials. Foreign currency (normally EURO and US Dollar) can be exchanged at the airport or the front desk of your hotel.

Local banks are open from 07.30 AM to 15.00 PM. from Saturday to Thursday .

There are also private foreign exchange offices throughout the city that operate between 09.00 AM to 17.00 PM.

Credit Cards:

Please note that credit cards are NOT accepted in Iran. You may arrange for cash payment during shopping or any small business activity.

Climate:

Normally in November, temperature in Tehran is between 05 to 15 degrees of Celsius. More accurate weather predicts will be available on the weather forecasting websites, one week prior to conference.

Electricity:

The current in Iran is 220 volts and 50 Hz

Time zone of Tehran is [GMT+3.5] in Iran and March 22, 2017 daylight saving starts.
